BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

9	<u>(b)</u>	Acting either alone or with one or more persons,			
10		commits or attempts to commit any of the following			
11		crimes and, in the course of and in furtherance of the			
12		crime that the person is committing or attempting to			
13		commit or during the immediate flight therefrom, the			
14		person, or another participant if there be any, causes			
15		the death of a person other than one of the			
16	participants:				
17		(i) Kidnapping, as defined in section 707-720;
