A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII HEALTH SYSTEMS CORPORATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	PART I		
2	SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary		
3	in chapter 323F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the Hawaii health		
4	systems corporation and Maui regional system board, for the		
5	purpose of removing the Maui regional health care system from		
6	the Hawaii health systems corporation, may sell, assign, or		
7	otherwise transfer title or interest in any or all assets of the		
8	Hawaii health systems corporation within the custody of the Maui		
9	regional system board pursuant to section 323F-7(c)(18), Hawaii		
10	Revised Statutes, or used by the Maui regional health care		
11	system in the normal course of its operations to deliver health		
12	care services; provided that:		
13	(1) The transfer shall be to a legally constituted entity;		
14	(2) The legally constituted entity shall be legally and		
15	financially capable, independent of the Hawaii health		
16	systems corporation, of continuing to provide the same		
17	level of health care services currently provided by		

1		the Maui regional health care system, for not less
2		than years after the transfer;
3	(3)	The transfer shall relieve the Hawaii health systems
4		corporation of all debts, obligations, and liabilities
5		of the Maui regional health care system, to the
6		reasonable satisfaction of the Hawaii health systems
7		corporation;
8	(4)	The transfer shall be approved by the:
9		(A) Legally constituted entity;
10		(B) Hawaii health systems corporation board;
11		(C) Maui regional system board; and
12		(D) Governor;
13		and
14	(5)	The transfer shall take effect no earlier than July 1,
15		2012.
16	SECT	ION 2. From the effective date of any transfer of the
17	Maui regio	onal health care system, chapter 323F, Hawaii Revised
18	Statutes,	and any other state law concerning the community
19	hospital	system, the Hawaii health systems corporation, or its
20	successor	shall not apply to the Maui regional health care
21	system or	Maui regional system board.

1	PART II
2	SECTION 3. Chapter 323F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
3	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
4	and to read as follows:
5	"§323F- Annual management and performance audit. (a)
6	The auditor shall annually perform a management and performance
7	audit of the corporation. The auditor shall contract with an
8	independent auditing entity that shall be authorized full access
9	to all information required for a complete and thorough
10	management and performance audit of the corporation. Funding
11	for all aspects of the audit shall be provided by the
12	corporation.
13	(b) The auditor shall submit a report of its findings and
14	recommendations, including:
15	(1) A full evaluation of all corporation assets,
16	liabilities, and contracts that deal with the
17	management, performance, and provision of services by
18	the corporation; and
19	(2) Any proposed legislation,
20	not less than twenty days prior to the beginning of each regular
21	session, beginning with the regular session of 2010."
