A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC HOUSING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 356D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately
3	designated and to read as follows:
4	"§356D- Smoking in and around public housing projects;
5	designated smoking areas. (a) The authority shall designate no
6	more than fifty per cent of the units in public housing projects
7	as smoking units. All smoking units on the same floor shall be
8	contiguous and smoke from these rooms shall not infiltrate into
9	areas where smoking is prohibited under this section. The
10	status of units as smoking or nonsmoking may not be changed,
11	except to add additional nonsmoking units.
12	(b) The authority shall designate one or more permissible
13	smoking areas not less than twenty feet from any residential
14	building or community facility of a public housing project.
15	(c) Smoking shall be prohibited in any public housing
16	project as defined in section 356D-1, or state low-income
17	housing project as defined in section 356D-51, within:
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1	(1)	Individual housing units not designated as smoking		
2		units pursuant to subsection (a);		
3	(2)	Hallways;		
4	(3)	Enclosed or partially enclosed common areas; and		
5	(4)	Twenty feet from any residential building or community		
6		facility of the public housing project.		
7	(d)	A person who smokes in an area where smoking is		
8	prohibite	d by this section shall be guilty of a violation, and:		
9	(1)	Upon a first violation, shall be fined not more than		
10		<u>\$50;</u>		
11	(2)	Upon a second violation, shall be fined not more than		
12		<u>\$100; and</u>		
13	(3)	Upon a third violation, shall be subject to eviction		
14		pursuant to section 356D-92.		
15	(e)	For purposes of this section:		
16	"Com	mon areas" means those portions of the land, building,		
17	and all appurtenances and easements that are available for use			
18	by all tenants of the public housing project or as designated by			
19	the authority as a common area.			
20	"Smoking" means inhaling or exhaling the fumes of tobacco			
21	or any other plant material, or burning or carrying any lighted			
22	smoking equipment for tobacco or any other plant material."			
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1	SECT	ION 2. Section 356D-92, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by	y amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
3	"(a)	Except as otherwise provided, the authority may
4	terminate	any lease, rental agreement, permit, or license
5	covering	the use and occupation of any dwelling unit or other
6	premises	located within a public housing project and evict from
7	any premi	ses any tenant, licensee, or other occupant for any of
8	the follo	wing reasons:
9	(1)	Failure to pay rent when due;
10	(2)	Violation of any of the provisions of a lease, rental
11		agreement, permit, or license;
12	(3)	Violation of any of the rules of the authority;
13	(4)	Failure to maintain the dwelling unit in a clean,
14		sanitary, and habitable condition; [or]
15	(5)	Upon a third violation of section 356D- ; provided
16		that a violation by a non-resident who is visiting a
17		resident shall be deemed a violation by the resident
18		only if the resident is within twenty feet of the
19		visitor at the time of the violation; or
20	[(5)]	(6) The existence of any other circumstances giving
21		rise to an immediate right to possession by the
22		authority."

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SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
begun, before its effective date.
SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Description:

Requires the Hawaii public housing authority to designate no more than fifty per cent of the units in public housing projects as smoking units; requires designation of smoking areas; prohibits smoking in and around public housing projects except in smoking units and designated smoking areas; establishes penalties.
