RELATING TO SEXUAL OFFENSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 706, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 3 and to read as follows: 4 Sexual offenses involving minors; enhanced "§706-5 sentencing. Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, 6 whenever a person is found guilty of any sexual offense that is 7 punishable as a felony under part V of chapter 707 and the victim is less than eighteen years of age, the conviction shall 8 9 carry a mandatory minimum term of imprisonment of not less than 10 six months." 11 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that 12 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were 13 begun, before its effective date.

14 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.

15 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
