A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGRICULTURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. A viable agriculture industry requires a
- 2 steady, reliable supply of water. However, drought conditions
- 3 continue to adversely affect the State's farms and ranches,
- 4 hampering their ability to produce quality products on a
- 5 consistent basis throughout the year.
- 6 The legislature finds that to address the harmful impacts
- 7 of droughts, mitigation measures laid out in the Hawaii drought
- 8 plan must be implemented. The goal of the Hawaii drought plan
- 9 is to develop coordinated emergency response mechanisms while at
- 10 the same time outlining steps toward mitigating the effects of
- 11 future drought occurrences. The Hawaii drought plan provides
- 12 clear policies and designates entities to implement immediate,
- 13 short-term, and long-term response measures to mitigate the
- 14 impact of droughts.
- 15 The legislature also finds that in 2004, county drought
- 16 committees were formed for each of the four counties in Hawaii.
- 17 Each of the county drought committees developed a drought

- 1 mitigation strategy for its respective county, with a focus on
- 2 drought mitigation projects. These county drought mitigation
- 3 strategies represent the local needs and concerns of each county
- 4 and are incorporated by reference into the Hawaii drought plan.
- 5 The legislature further finds that to adequately implement
- 6 the Hawaii drought plan, sufficient funding for the counties is
- 7 necessary to address the many challenges that our agriculture
- 8 industry faces in preparing for droughts.
- 9 The purpose of this Act is to provide funding to pursue
- 10 drought mitigation projects and measures in each county of the
- 11 State.
- 12 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 13 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$4,000,000 or so much
- 14 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010 and the
- 15 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 16 2010-2011 for drought mitigation projects and measures in each
- 17 county of the State; provided that the department of land and
- 18 natural resources shall work with the drought committee of each
- 19 county of the State so that at least one project is funded for
- 20 each county.
- 21 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 22 of land and natural resources for the purposes of this Act.
