## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 304A-105, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows: 3 "(b) The board of regents shall develop internal policies 4 and procedures for the procurement of goods, services, and 5 construction, consistent with the goals of public accountability 6 and public procurement practices, but shall not be subject to 7 chapter 103D. Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, 8 chapter 103D shall not apply to any actions or activities 9 undertaken, conducted, or performed under authority of the board 10 of regents or of the university. When it is possible, the board is encouraged to use the provisions of chapter 103D as 11 12 guidelines; provided that in using one or more provisions of 13 chapter 103D as guidelines, neither the board nor the university 14 shall be: 15 Deemed to have waived in any way the exemption from (1)

the requirements and applicability of chapter 103D
