A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LIMITING CIVIL LIABILITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 663, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 3 and to read as follows: 4 "§663- Owner to felon; limited liability. (a) An 5 owner, including but not limited to a public entity, of any 6 estate or any other interest in real property, whether 7 possessory or nonpossessory, or any agent of the owner lawfully 8 on the premises by consent of the owner, shall not be liable to 9 any perpetrator engaged in any of the felonies set forth in 10 subsection (b) for any injury or death to the perpetrator that 11 occurs upon that property during the course of or after the 12 commission of such felony, or when a reasonable person would 13 believe that commission of a felony as set forth in subsection 14 (b) is imminent; provided that if the perpetrator is injured, 15 the perpetrator is charged with the criminal offense and 16 convicted of the criminal offense or of a lesser included felony 17 or misdemeanor.
