A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO VEHICLE EMISSIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 The legislature finds that Hawaii is faced with SECTION 1. 2 a rising number of automobiles traveling its highways each year 3 and that the increasing number of automobiles is a major source of air pollution and a danger to Hawaii's environment. As we 4 5 are faced with the threat of global warming and environmental 6 devastation on a global scale, we must act to reduce its effects 7 here in Hawaii. One path to a cleaner environment in Hawaii is 8 through the adoption of vehicle emissions standards that closely 9 regulate allowable emissions and encourage cleaner, fuel 10 efficient vehicles. California has been a pioneer in this area 11 of air pollution prevention, adopting strict vehicle emissions 12 standards in the 1970's. Since then, California has revised its 13 standards, and other states are beginning to follow suit by adopting similar pollution control measures. 14

15 The purpose of this Act is to direct the department of 16 health to adopt rules that establish vehicle emissions and fuel 17 efficiency standards that meet or exceed those in California.

4	SECTION 2. Chapter 342B, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
5	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated		
6	and to read as follows:		
7	"S342B- Motor vehicle emissions standards; rules. (a)		
8	No later than January 1, 2011, the director of health shall		
9	adopt rules, pursuant to chapter 91, to implement statewide		
10	requirements for vehicle emissions and fuel efficiency that meet		
11	or exceed the standards for vehicle emissions and fuel		
12	efficiency found in the California low emission vehicle program.		
13	(b) The rules adopted under subsection (a) shall apply to		
14	all new motor vehicles sold or offered for lease in the State		
15	with a model year of 2011 or later.		
16	(c) The department:		
17	(1) May implement the requirements in phases;		
18	(2) Shall provide appropriate enforcement and		
19	administrative penalties for any manufacturer or		
20	seller that violates the rules adopted pursuant to		
21	this section; and		



1	(3)	Shall amend the rules from time to time to maintain
2		optimum levels of emissions reduction and fuel
3		efficiency and to maintain emission levels consistent
4		with those specified in the California low emission
5		vehicle program.

Section 342B-72, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 12 13 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 14 Before December 31, 2011, the director shall adopt "(a) 15 rules pursuant to chapter 91: 16 Establishing greenhouse gas emission limits applicable (1)17 to sources or categories of sources, including motor 18 vehicle emissions, to be achieved by January 1, 2020, 19 and establishing emission reduction measures to 20 achieve the maximum practically and technically feasible and cost-effective reductions in greenhouse 21



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1gas emissions in furtherance of achieving the2statewide greenhouse gas emissions limit; and3(2)Requiring the reporting and verification of statewide4greenhouse gas emissions and to monitor and enforce5compliance with this part,

6 to become operative beginning on January 1, 2012."

7 SECTION 5. The director of health shall submit a report to
8 the legislature summarizing the Hawaii low emission vehicle
9 program, including any proposed legislation necessary to
10 implement and enforce the program, no later than twenty days
11 prior to the convening of the regular session of 2010.

SECTION 6. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketedand stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

14 SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect upon approval.
