BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 132D-17, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended to read as follows:

"§132D-17 Inconsistent county ordinances, rules. 3 4 Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, no county shall 5 enact ordinances or adopt any rules regulating fireworks or 6 articles pyrotechnic, except as required in this chapter, that 7 is [inconsistent with or more] less restrictive than[, the 8 provisions of] this chapter. Any ordinances and rules regulating fireworks or articles pyrotechnic that were enacted 9 or adopted by a county before March 31, 1995, except those 10 provisions [which] that are not inconsistent with, or [more] 11 less restrictive than those of this chapter, are declared void." 12 13 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 14 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
