### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO INSURANCE.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 431, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to article 10A to be
3	appropriately designated and to read as follows:
4	"§431:10A- Group health care coverage; part-time
5	employees. An insurer that provides health care coverage in the
6	State to the regular employees of any group or association shall
7	offer the same coverage to part-time employees of that group or
8	association; provided that the group or association shall not be
9	required by this section to pay any part of the premium for that
10	coverage.
11	For the purposes of this section:
12	"Group or association" shall not include any state or
13	political subdivision of any state, or instrumentality thereof.
14	"Health care" includes hospitalization, surgery, medical or
15	nursing care, drugs, or restorative appliances.
16	"Part-time employee" means a person employed in the
17 :	employment of a single employer for at least fifteen, but less

18 than twenty hours per week.

4	SECTION 4. (a) The insurance commissioner shall prepare a
5	report of the costs and benefits of this Act. The report shall
6	be prepared with the cooperation and assistance of the
7	disability compensation division of the department of labor and
8	industrial relations. The report shall include:
9	(1) An evaluation of the success of this Act in providing
10	part-time employees with access to health care
11	coverage;
12	(2) An evaluation of the costs to employees, employers,
13	and insurers of providing that coverage;
14	(3) Any recommendations concerning this Act; and
15	(4) Any other information necessary for a reasonable
16	assessment of the costs and benefits of this Act to be
17	made, and to allow health care coverage to be made
18	available to part-time employees at the lowest
19	possible cost.
20	(b) Each insurer subject to this Act shall submit, at the
21	time and in the form prescribed by the insurance commissioner,
22	the information deemed necessary by the insurance commissioner

1 to complete the report required by this section. In obtaining 2 this information, the insurance commissioner shall seek to 3 minimize an insurer's cost of compliance. 4 (c) The insurance commissioner shall report findings, 5 recommendations, and any proposed legislation to the legislature 6 not later than twenty days prior to the convening of the regular 7 session of 2011. 8 SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 9 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 10 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2010,

11 and shall be repealed on July 1, 2011.
