BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 132D-17, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended to read as follows:
3	"§132D-17 Inconsistent county ordinances, rules. (a)
4	[Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, no] Subject to
5	the limitation established in subsection (b), a county [shall]
6	may enact ordinances or adopt any rules regulating fireworks or
7	articles pyrotechnic[, except as required in this chapter,] that
8	[is inconsistent with or] are more restrictive than[7] the
9	provisions of this chapter. Any ordinances and rules regulating
10	fireworks or articles pyrotechnic that were enacted or adopted
11	by a county before March 31, 1995[, except those provisions
12	which] and are [not inconsistent with, or more] less restrictive
13	than those of this chapter, are declared void.
14	(b) A county may not enact ordinances or adopt rules that
15	impose a total ban of fireworks or articles pyrotechnic."
16	SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
17	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval. 1
