RELATING TO LIQUOR LICENSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 281-60, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 3 "(a) Except as provided for in section 281-13, if an 4 applicant has at any time been denied or refused a license, no 5 further application from the applicant pertaining to the same 6 class of license on the same premises or building location shall 7 be considered for [one year] three years from the denial or 8 refusal[-]; provided further that no further application from 9 the applicant pertaining to a different class of license on the 10 same premises or building location shall be considered for one 11 year from the denial or refusal." 12 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 13 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 14 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2009.
