A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 304A-402, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows:

3 "[4] §304A-402[4] Residence for tuition purposes; basic

rule. The board of regents shall adopt the necessary rules

5 defining residence for tuition purposes herein; provided that

the basic rule shall be that a student shall qualify for the

resident tuition fee only if the following criteria are met:

- (1) The adult student, or in the case of a minor student, the student's parents or guardians, has or have been a bona fide resident of this State for at least twelve consecutive months next preceding the student's first day of officially scheduled instruction for any semester or term in which the student is enrolling at the particular college or campus; and
- (2) The adult or minor student has not been claimed as a dependent for tax purposes for at least twelve months next preceding the student's first day of officially scheduled instruction for any semester or term in

1	which the student is enrolling at the particular
2	college or campus by the student's parents or
3	guardians who are nonresidents of the State; provided
4	that this provision shall not apply in cases where the
5	parent claiming the student as a dependent is entitled
6	to do so under a child support order or agreement
7	issued or entered into in conjunction with a divorce
8	proceeding or legal separation agreement and the other
9	parent and the student meet the criteria set forth in
10	paragraph (1) [-] <u>;</u>
11	provided that a veteran who is a resident of any state shall
12	also qualify for the resident tuition fee. As used in this
13	section, "veteran" means any person who has served in the armed
14	services of the United States and who was discharged or released
15	therefrom under conditions other than dishonorable."
16	SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
17	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
18	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010 and
19	the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
20	year 2010-2011 for the University of Hawaii to grant resident
21	status to veterans enrolled at any campus of the University of
22	Hawaii system.
