RELATING TO TUITION ASSISTANCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 121-45, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 3 "(a) The adjutant general, subject to the availability of 4 funds, may award tuition assistance to qualified enlisted 5 persons, warrant officers, and [company grade] commissioned and general officers $\left[\frac{(0-1 \text{ through } 0-3)}{(0-1 \text{ through } 0-3)}\right]$ in the Hawaii national 6 7 quard who are: Residents of the State, as defined by the board of 8 (1)9 regents pursuant to section [+]304A-402[+]; and 10 (2) [Undergraduate students] Students working toward a 11 degree on any campus of the University of Hawaii." 12 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general 13 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so 14 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010 and 15 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal 16 year 2010-2011 to provide tuition assistance to members of the 17 Hawaii national guard who are students working toward a degree 18 on any campus of the University of Hawaii system. of defense for the purposes of this Act.
