A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LEGISLATIVE REAPPORTIONMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Section 25-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

 "(a) Legislative reapportionment. The commission shall
 reapportion the members of each house of the legislature on the
- 5 basis, method, and criteria prescribed by the Constitution of
- 6 the United States and article IV of the Hawaii Constitution $[-]_{\underline{i}}$
- 7 provided that the commission shall apportion the house of
- 8 representatives among multi-member districts of not more than
- 9 three members that conform to the boundaries of senate
- 10 districts, where practicable. Pursuant thereto, the commission
- 11 shall conduct public hearings and consult with the apportionment
- 12 advisory council of each basic island unit. Not more than one
- 13 hundred days from the date on which all members are certified,
- 14 the commission shall cause to be given in each basic island
- 15 unit, public notice of a legislative reapportionment plan
- 16 prepared and proposed by the commission. At least one public
- 17 hearing on the proposed reapportionment plan shall be held in

- 1 each basic island unit after initial public notice of the plan.
- 2 At least twenty days' notice shall be given of the public
- 3 hearing. The notice shall include a statement of the substance
- 4 of the proposed reapportionment plan, and of the date, time, and
- 5 place where interested persons may be heard thereon. The notice
- 6 shall be given at least once in the basic island unit where the
- 7 hearing will be held. All interested persons shall be afforded
- 8 an opportunity to submit data, views, or arguments, orally or in
- 9 writing, for consideration by the commission. After the last of
- 10 the public hearings, but in no event later than one hundred
- 11 fifty days from the date on which all members of the commission
- 12 are certified, the commission shall determine whether or not the
- 13 plan is in need of correction or modification, make the
- 14 correction or modification, if any, and file with the chief
- 15 election officer, a final legislative reapportionment plan.
- 16 Within fourteen days after the filing of the final
- 17 reapportionment plan, the chief election officer shall cause
- 18 public notice to be given of the final legislative
- 19 reapportionment plan which, upon public notice, shall become
- 20 effective as of the date of filing and govern the election of
- 21 members of the next five succeeding legislatures."

- 1 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 2 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
