A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ELECTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

| 1 | SECTION 1. The legislature finds that county neighborhood |
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| 2 | boards have very competitive elections with more candidates |
| 3 | receiving campaign contributions to finance their election. The |
| 4 | legislature is concerned about possible undue interest group |
| 5 | influence in the neighborhood board elections, in view of the |
| 6 | current practice of mailing out newsletters, brochures, or door |
| 7 | flyers to promote a candidate. |
| 8 | The legislature further finds that campaign contributions |
| 9 | used by candidates for neighborhood boards to finance the |
| 10 | printing and mailing of campaign materials should be disclosed. |
| 11 | The purpose of this Act is to: |
| 12 | (1) Repeal the exclusion of county neighborhoods boards |
| 13 | from the election campaign contributions and |
| 14 | expenditures law; and |
| 15 | (2) Require an organizational report to be filed with the |
| 16 | campaign spending commission by any neighborhood board |
| 17 | candidate who receives contributions or makes |

| 1 | expenditures of more than a specified statutory amoun |
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| 2 | for the printing and mailing of campaign material. |
| 3 | SECTION 2. Section 11-191, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is |
| 4 | amended by amending the definition of "office" to read as |
| 5 | follows: |
| 6 | ""Office" means any elective public or constitutional |
| 7 | office excluding [county neighborhood board and] federal |
| 8 | elective offices." |
| 9 | SECTION 3. Section 11-194, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is |
| 10 | amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows: |
| 11 | "(b) Each candidate shall file an organizational report |
| 12 | within ten days of: |
| 13 | (1) Filing the nomination papers for office; or |
| 14 | (2) The date the candidate or candidate's committee |
| 15 | receives contributions or makes expenditures that |
| 16 | amount to more than \$100 in the aggregate during the |
| 17 | applicable election period, whichever occurs |
| 18 | first $[-]$, or in the case of a candidate for a |
| 19 | neighborhood board, the date the candidate or |
| 20 | candidate's committee receives contributions or makes |
| 21 | expenditures that amount to more than \$1,000, for |
| 22 | printing, mailings, and related expenditure for |

| 1 | printing and mailings in the aggregate during the |
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| 2 | applicable election period, whichever occurs first." |

Description:

Applies the election campaign contributions and expenditures law to candidates for the neighborhood boards; requires candidates for neighborhood board elections to file an organizational report with the campaign spending commission regarding campaign contributions used for printing and mailing campaign material.
