A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LANDFILLS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the Waimanalo Gulch landfill, located on the leeward coast, is the only existing landfill on Oahu that is capable of receiving the total daily output of non-reusable municipal solid waste. It is also the only municipal solid waste facility owned by the city and county of Honolulu that receives approximately four hundred thousand tons of municipal solid waste every year.

8 The legislature further finds that the department of health 9 has issued citations and fines to the city and county of 10 Honolulu and to Waimanalo Gulch landfill's contracted operator, 11 Waste Management Hawaii, for violations, such as exceeding the 12 landfill's allowed height, failure to cover garbage with soil 13 daily, failure to monitor levels of methane gas, failure to 14 measure and maintain records of liquid levels in landfill sump 15 pumps, and failure to record locations of asbestos disposal. 16 Because of these conditions, residents along the leeward coast 17 continue to experience many health-related problems including

asthma, cancer, and other serious illnesses that may be a result
of the presence of the landfill.

3 With the expected growth in the amount of municipal solid waste generated on Oahu, the city and county of Honolulu created 4 5 a blue ribbon panel in 2003 to study the possibility of a new 6 location for municipal solid waste disposal. Despite the 7 existence of the Waimanalo Gulch landfill on the leeward coast 8 for eighteen years, however, the blue ribbon panel's 9 recommendations for a new location were still largely biased 10 toward siting a new landfill on the leeward coast.

11 The purpose of this Act is to place a moratorium for any 12 new landfills or the expansion of any existing private solid 13 waste landfill unit on the leeward coast including Nanakuli, 14 Waianae, Maili, Makaha, and Makua on or after August 1, 2009. 15 SECTION 2. Chapter 342H, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 16 amended by adding a new section to part IV to be appropriately 17 designated and to read as follows:

18 "<u>\$342H-</u> Leeward coast landfills; moratorium. Any law to 19 the contrary notwithstanding, no person, including any 20 government agency or entity, shall construct or operate a new 21 solid waste landfill unit or expand any existing private solid

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1	waste landfill unit, or any component thereof, on or after
2	August 1, 2009, within the Oahu areas of:
3	(1) Nanakuli;
4	(2) Waianae;
5	(3) Maili;
6	(4) Makaha; and
7	(5) Makua;
8	provided that this section shall not apply to any municipal
9	solid waste landfill units existing prior to August 1, 2009, in
10	these areas.
11	For purposes of this section, "new solid waste landfill
12	unit" means any solid waste landfill unit that has not received
13	waste prior to August 1, 2009."
14	SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
15	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
