## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CABLE TELEVISION SYSTEMS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 440G, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is			
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated			
3	and to read as follows:			
4	"§440G- Designation of access organizations for PEG			
5	access channels. (a) The director may designate one or more			
6	access organizations to oversee the development, operation,			
7	supervision, management, production, and broadcasting of			
8	programs of public, educational, or governmental access			
9	facilities obtained under this chapter, rules of the department,			
10	or order of the director; provided that:			
11	(1) The requirements for designating an access			
12	organization shall be prescribed by rule adopted in			
13	accordance with chapter 91;			
14	(2) The director shall by contract:			
15	(A) Designate access organizations;			
16	(B) Set forth terms and conditions for the operation			
17	of the access organization, which shall be fair			

1			to the public, taking into account the
2			geographic, topographic, and economic
3			characteristics of the service area, and the
4			economics of providing cable access in the
5			service area;
6		(C)	Identify government-owned property, government-
7			furnished property, and contractor-acquired
8			property held by the access organization in which
9			the State retains title, and establish the
10			parties' obligation with respect to the property;
11			and
12		(D)	Require the access organization, upon termination
13			or expiration of the contract, to return
14			unobligated funds received under the contract to
15			the State or its designee, pursuant to the cost
16			principles of section 103D-601 and rules adopted
17			thereunder;
18	<u>(3)</u>	Notw:	ithstanding any other provision to the contrary in
19		chapt	ter 103D, the designation of an access
20		orgai	nization shall be exempt from the requirements of
21		chapt	ter 103D; provided that this exemption shall not

1	•	apply to procurements made by any access organization;

3	(4)	A contract designating an access organization shall			
4		not be perpetual.			
5	(b)	Any decision designating, modifying, or rescinding the			
6	designati	on of an access organization or the requirements			
7	therefor	shall first be submitted to the cable advisory			
8	committee established by section 440G-13."				
9	SECTION 2. Section 440G-13, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is				
10	amended to read as follows:				
11	"§440G-13 Cable advisory committee. (a) There is				
12	establish	ed the cable advisory committee. The committee shall			
13	consist o	f five members appointed by the governor as provided in			
14	section 26-34.				
15	The	committee shall advise [ <del>the</del> ]:			
16	(1)	The director [and], cable operators, and access			
17		organizations on matters within the jurisdiction of			
18		this chapter at the request of the director [ox], any			
19		cable operator [-], or any access organization; and			
20	(2)	The director on any decision designating, modifying,			
21		or rescinding a designation of an access organization			

1	or the requirements therefor, as provided in section
2	440G
3	(b) The members of the committee shall serve without pay
4	but shall be entitled to reimbursement for necessary expenses
5	while attending meetings and while in discharge of their
6	duties."
7	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
8	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
9	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2010.
