RELATING TO CABLE TELEVISION SYSTEMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 440G, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	"§440G- Designation of access organizations for PEG
5	access channels. (a) The director may designate one or more
6	access organizations to oversee the development, operation,
7	supervision, management, production, and broadcasting of
8	programs of public, educational, or governmental access
9	facilities obtained under this chapter, rules of the department,
10	or order of the director; provided that:
11	(1) The requirements to designate an access organization
12	shall be prescribed in rules adopted in accordance
13	with chapter 91;
14	(2) Notwithstanding any other provision to the contrary in
15	chapter 103D, a contract that designates an access
16	organization shall be exempt from the requirements of
17	chapter 103D; provided that any such exemption shall

	only apply to the letting of the contract and not to
	any specific access organization;
(3)	The director shall enter into a contract or contracts
	with each designated access organization and shall
	ensure that the terms and conditions required of the
	operation of an access organization designated under
	subsection (a) are fair to the public, taking into
	account the geographic, topographic, and economic
	characteristics of the service area and the economics
	of providing cable access in the service area;
(4)	All property, facilities, and equipment purchased from
	funds provided by order of the director to an access
	organization shall automatically revert to the State
	or its designee upon termination of the contract;
<u>(5)</u>	All unspent funds provided by order of the director to
	an access organization shall automatically revert to
	the State or its designee upon termination of the
	contract; and
(6)	The contract shall not be perpetual.
