A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO RENTAL HOUSING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that providing affordable
- 2 rental housing to Hawaii's low income residents is a continuing
- 3 challenge and that current economic conditions make this goal
- 4 even more difficult to meet.
- 5 Act 100, Session Laws of Hawaii 2006, as amended by Act
- 6 222, Session Laws of Hawaii 2007, assisted with this effort by
- 7 temporarily increasing the percentage of the conveyance tax paid
- 8 into the rental housing trust fund from thirty to fifty per cent
- 9 for two years, until June 30, 2008.
- 10 The purpose of this Act is to increase permanently the
- 11 percentage of the conveyance tax paid into the rental housing
- 12 trust fund from the current allocation of thirty per cent, to
- 13 sixty-five per cent.
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 201H-202, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 15 amended by amending subsection (i) to read as follows:
- 16 "(i) For the period commencing July 1, 2005, [through
- 17 June 30, 2009, the fund may be used to provide grants for



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- 1 rental units set aside for persons and families with incomes at
- 2 or below thirty per cent of the median family income in any
- 3 project financed in whole or in part by the fund in proportion
- 4 of those units to the total number of units in the project. [At
- 5 the conclusion of the period described in this subsection, the]
- 6 The corporation shall report annually to the legislature on the
- 7 number and use of grants provided and whether the grants were an
- 8 effective use of the funds for purposes of developing rental
- 9 housing for families at or below thirty per cent of the median
- 10 family income."
- 11 SECTION 3. Section 247-7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 12 amended to read as follows:
- 13 "S247-7 Disposition of taxes. All taxes collected each
- 14 fiscal year under this chapter shall be paid [into the state
- 15 treasury to the credit of the general fund of the State, to be
- 16 used and expended for the purposes for which the general fund
- 17 was created and exists by law; provided that of the taxes
- 18 collected each fiscal year:] as follows:
- 19 (1) Ten per cent shall be paid into the land conservation
- fund established pursuant to section 173A-5;

4	(3)	Twen	ty-five per cent shall be paid into the natural
5		area	reserve fund established by section 195-9;

9		following priority:	
10		(A)	To natural area partnership and forest
11			stewardship programs after joint consultation
12			with the forest stewardship committee and the
13		r	natural area reserves system commission;
14		(B)	Projects undertaken in accordance with watershed
15			management plans pursuant to section 171-58 or
16			watershed management plans negotiated with
17			private landowners, and management of the natural
18			area reserves system pursuant to section 195-3;

20		(C)	The youth conservation corps established under
21			chapter 193."
