# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that more reserved 2 housing units are needed in the Kakaako mauka area. Time is 3 critical in the development of housing projects and delays in obtaining the necessary approvals or the requirement of multiple 4 governmental approvals may jeopardize projects. Currently, 5 planned development projects requiring either a consolidation or 6 7 subdivision of land must seek approvals from both the Hawaii 8 community development authority and the city and county of 9 Honolulu.

10 The purpose of this Act is to authorize the Hawaii 11 community development authority to process an application for 12 subdivision and consolidation of land for a planned development 13 project with at least twenty per cent of the total number of 14 dwelling units in the project reserved for sale or rental to 15 qualified persons as determined by the authority.

4	" <u>§206E-</u> Planned development project; reserved housing;

6	law to the contrary, the authority shall process an application
7	for subdivision and consolidation of land for a planned
8	development project with at least twenty per cent of the total
9	number of dwelling units in the project reserved for sale or
10	rental to qualified persons as determined by the authority.
11	(b) For any planned development project with at least
12	twenty per cent of the total number of dwelling units in the
13	project reserved for sale or rental to qualified persons as
14	determined by the authority, the following review periods shall
15	apply:
16	(1) Project eligibility review shall be completed by the:
17	(A) City and county of Honolulu and any other
18	governmental agency within thirty days; and
19	(B) Authority within forty-five days after receipt of
20	the application for a planned development, at
21	which time a written project eligibility
22	determination shall be issued to the applicant;

1	(2)	Action on the application for a planned development
2		shall be taken by the authority within forty-five days
3		after the date the authority issues a written project
4		eligibility determination; provided that the
5		application shall be deemed approved if no decision is
6		made by the authority in granting or denying the
7		application within the forty-five day time period; and
8	(3)	Action on the application for subdivision or
9		consolidation of land shall be taken by the authority
10		within ninety days after the date the application for
11		subdivision or consolidation is deemed complete by the
12		authority. If an applicant for a planned development
13		project with at least twenty per cent of the total
14		number of dwelling units in the project reserved for
15		sale or rental to qualified persons as determined by
16		the authority requires subdivision or consolidation
17		approval, the application for subdivision or
18		consolidation shall be submitted together with the
19		planned development application. The application
20		shall be deemed approved if no decision is made by the
21		authority in granting or denying the application
22		within the ninety-day time period.
