## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HISTORIC PLACES.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 708, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "\$708-A Criminal trespass; historic sites. In addition to
- 5 meeting all of the required elements for conviction under
- 6 sections 708-813, 708-814, or 708-815, if a person is found to
- 7 have criminally trespassed on property that is listed on the
- 8 Hawai`i Register of Historic Places, the prescribed criminal
- 9 penalty under the respective sections shall be increased to the
- 10 next highest level of punishment."
- 11 SECTION 2. Chapter 708, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 12 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 13 and to read as follows:
- 14 "§708-B Criminal property damage; historic sites. In
- 15 addition to meeting all of the required elements for conviction
- 16 under sections 708-821, 708-822, or 708-823, if a person is
- 17 found to have damaged property that is listed on the Hawai`i



- 1 Register of Historic Places, the prescribed criminal penalty
- 2 under the respective sections shall be increased to the next
- 3 highest level of punishment."
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 5 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 6 begun, before its effective date.
- 7 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
- 8 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
