A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TOURISM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. No later than December 31, 2012, all signs 2 currently identifying state landmarks, as determined by the 3 state and the Hawaii Visitors and Conventions Bureau, shall be 4 replaced with signs that convey interpretive information. 5 For purposes of this Act, "signs that convey interpretive information" means signage erected to provide information to the 6 7 public on the environmental, historic, cultural, or other values 8 of a building, site, or landmark. 9 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its approval. 10
