A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR ADVANCED PLACEMENT AND INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE COURSES AT PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOLS STATEWIDE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that according to a study
- 2 conducted by the Southern Regional Education Board in July 2007,
- 3 growth in the participation of advanced placement and
- 4 International Baccalaureate courses in the states served by the
- 5 board has led to a higher percentage of proficiency rates that
- 6 have exceeded the national averages. In addition, according to
- 7 the College Board, a not-for-profit examination board, advanced
- 8 placement courses allow students to challenge themselves with
- 9 rigorous college-level courses in high school and earn college
- 10 credit through their success in the advanced placement
- 11 examination. The International Baccalaureate Organization has
- 12 found that their students consistently attain admission into
- 13 prestigious universities around the world such as Oxford
- 14 University, University of British Columbia, and Harvard
- 15 University.
- 16 The legislature further finds that in a study conducted by
- 17 the Massachusetts Institute of Technology, advanced placement



- 1 and International Baccalaureate students who earn credit through
- these programs perform better than the average student, and that 2
- 3 in research done by the National Center for Educational
- Accountability, students who take advanced placement and 4
- 5 International Baccalaureate courses are twice as likely to
- 6 graduate from college in five years than students who have not
- 7 attempted any of these courses.
- 8 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds for
- 9 advanced placement and International Baccalaureate courses in
- 10 Hawaii public schools that limit or do not offer these courses.
- 11 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 12 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$
- 13 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010 for
- 14 advanced placement and International Baccalaureate courses in
- 15 Hawaii public schools that limit or do not offer these courses.
- 16 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- education for the purposes of this Act. 17
- 18 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2009.
