A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO KUPUNA CARE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. On July 1, 1999, the executive office on aging
- 2 launched kupuna care, a statewide long-term care program
- 3 developed in partnership with the county area agencies on aging
- 4 to address the increasing number of elders needing long-term
- 5 care. The kupuna care program has been one of the most cost
- 6 effective programs delivering vital services to our elders. The
- 7 legislature finds that it is important to maintain critical
- 8 elder services and programs in the State, like kupuna care.
- 9 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to the
- 10 kupuna care program.
- 11 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 12 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$1,025,000 or so much
- 13 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010 and the
- 14 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 15 2010-2011 to fund the kupuna care program.
- 16 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 17 of health for the purposes of this Act.
