A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SENTENCING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to repeal the
- 2 special sentencing of habitual violent felons, commonly known as
- 3 the "three strikes" law, adopted by the legislature as Act 81 in
- 4 2006. The legislature finds that Act 81 is overly broad, will
- 5 lead to prison overcrowding and incur excessive costs for
- 6 prisoner care and prison operation, and is superfluous in light
- 7 of existing law which already provides for enhanced sentencing
- 8 of repeat offenders. It deprives courts of the discretion
- 9 needed to formulate appropriate, individualized sentences.
- 10 Moreover, despite the claim by various law enforcement officials
- 11 that its adoption was necessary to protect the public from
- 12 dangerous criminals, the legislature finds that this law has not
- 13 been used once since its passage.
- 14 SECTION 2. Act 81, Session Laws of Hawaii 2006, is
- 15 repealed.
