6 WHEREAS, the public school system includes the Office of 7 School Facilities and Support Services; Office of Curriculum, 8 Instruction and Student Support; Office of Fiscal Services; 9 Office of Human Resources; Office of Information Technology 10 Services; and administrative district offices for seven school 11 complexes composed of Honolulu, Central Oahu, Leeward Oahu, 12 Windward Oahu, Hawaii, Maui, and Kauai; and

14 WHEREAS, the Department of Education is also involved with
15 the Advisory Council for Hawaii State Adult and Community
16 Education, library advisory commissions, the Teacher Education
17 Coordinating Committee, the Educational Officer
18 Classification/Compensation Appeals Board, and the Hawaii
19 Teacher Standards Board; and

21 WHEREAS, issues have arisen as to whether the Department of 22 Education's comprehensive management system has fully 23 implemented fundamental management controls to ensure efficiency 24 in leadership, responsibility, and accountability; and 25

WHEREAS, the Auditor has not conducted comprehensive management audit of the Department of Education's management system since 1973 ("Management Audit of the Department of Education", February 1973, Audit Report No. 73-1); and 30

31 WHEREAS, the Department of Education could benefit from 32 having more consistent and systematic oversight of middle-33 management in the performance of the Department's tasks; now, 34 therefore,
