## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A NATIONAL HEALTH BOARD TO ENSURE QUALITY HEALTHCARE FOR ALL RESIDENTS OF THE UNITED STATES.

1 2 3	WHEREAS, every American deserves access to affordable quality health care; and
5 4 5 6 7	WHEREAS, the cost of health insurance is now rising at a rate that is making the procurement of such insurance unaffordable; and
7 8 9 10 11	WHEREAS, competition among private health insurance plans has not made health care more affordable or more accessible to Americans but, in fact, has had the opposite effect; and
12 13 14 15	WHEREAS, pressure to hold down health care costs and maximize profits has led to strong financial incentives for private health plans to use underwriting strategies to avoid or limit covering the sick; and
16 17 18 19 20 21 22 23	WHEREAS, for physicians and other health care providers, such as hospitals, competition among private health insurance plans has resulted in reduced fees, increased managed care paperwork and bureaucratic requirements, increased administrative costs, and increased obstacles to the payment of claims; and
24 25 26 27 28 29	WHEREAS, the private practice of medicine is now being threatened by the increasing power of health plans to set fees and force physicians to accept onerous and unfunded managed care policies; and WHEREAS, comparisons with other countries' health care
30 31 32	systems and economic analyses have repeatedly shown that a single-payer health care financing system with universal coverage of all residents would cost less and provide better



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overall care than any proposal involving competing private 1 2 health insurance plans; and 3 4 WHEREAS, if all Americans were covered by a single-payer 5 health plan it would eliminate pre-existing condition exclusions, cost-shifting, disputes over who is responsible for 6 7 paying for care, and the ties between employment and healthcare 8 coverage; and 9 WHEREAS, the removal of health care costs from litigation 10 would result in large savings in medical malpractice, workers' 11 12 compensation, and automobile insurance costs; now, therefore, 13 14 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-fifth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2010, the 15 16 House of Representatives concurring, that Congress is urged to enact legislation to establish a single-payer health care 17 financing system for the United States; and 18 19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Congress and the Federal 20 21 Executive Branch is urged to create a National Health Board, held accountable to act on behalf of the public good and 22 insulated from special interest influences; and 23 24 25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Board shall have expertise in health economics and representation from the actual 26 stakeholders in health care including physicians, hospitals, and 27 other providers of health care and the public; and 28 29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the National Health Board shall 30 be granted authority over the establishment of a provider fee 31 structure, allocation of government funding for health care 32 education and training, medical research, public health 33 programs, scope of practice issues, and quality improvement 34 35 programs; and 36 37 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the National Health Board shall have substantial authority over the public financing of the 38 single-payer health care system, including health care taxes, to 39 ensure that the funding of the system continues to reflect the 40 realistic costs of providing quality health care, to ensure that 41 42 public health care funds are spent in a cost-effective manner, and to ensure maintenance of quality health care for the 43 44 residents of the United States in perpetuity; and
