SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

ENCOURAGING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO ESTABLISH AT LEAST ONE SERVICE LEARNING COORDINATOR IN EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL.

1 WHEREAS, the National Service-Learning Clearinghouse 2 defines service learning as "a teaching and learning strategy 3 that integrates meaningful community service with instruction 4 and reflection to enrich the learning experience, teach civic 5 responsibility, and strengthen communities"; and

7 WHEREAS, service learning is an effective method of 8 developing civic responsibility, service ethic, and leadership 9 and social skills while enhancing classroom learning; and 10

11 WHEREAS, Hawaii's schools currently engage in service 12 learning projects, supported by a comprehensive student support 13 system established by Board of Education Policy No. 2203, with 14 one of its main functions being the involvement of families and 15 community stakeholders as partners in the education process; and 16

WHEREAS, service learning efforts should be encouraged and further developed, and designating at least one person at each public school as a service learning coordinator would encourage and further develop service learning; now, therefore, 21

BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-fifth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2010, the House of Representatives concurring, that the Department of Education is encouraged to designate at least one service learning coordinator at each public school; and

28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the designated service learning 29 coordinator at each public school:

> Coordinate service learning projects for students at that school;
