## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

CONVENING A LEGISLATIVE NOISE POLLUTION TASK FORCE TO REVIEW BEST PRACTICES FROM OTHER STATES IN REDUCING URBAN NOISE POLLUTION.

WHEREAS, the traditional definition of noise is "unwanted 1 2 or disturbing sound," which becomes unwanted when it either 3 interferes with normal activities such as sleeping or 4 conversation, or disrupts or diminishes one's quality of life; 5 and 6 7 WHEREAS, the fact that you cannot see, taste, or smell 8 noise may help explain why it has not received as much attention as other types of pollution, such as air or water pollution; and 9 10 11 WHEREAS, noise pollution can have major consequences, primarily to a person's overall health; and 12 13 WHEREAS, studies have shown that there are direct links 14 between noise and health, and problems related to noise 15 including stress related illnesses, high blood pressure, speech 16 interference, hearing loss, sleep disruption, and lost 17 productivity; and 18 19 WHEREAS, noise-induced hearing loss is the most common and 20 commonly-discussed health effect, but research has shown that 21 22 exposure to constant or high levels of noise can cause countless 23 adverse health effects; now, therefore, 24 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-fifth 25 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2010, the 26 House of Representatives concurring, that there is convened a 27 Legislative Noise Pollution Task Force (Task Force) to review 28 best practices from other states in reducing noise pollution; 29 30 and
