SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS TO ADOPT RULES TO PROHIBIT ABUSIVE WORK ENVIRONMENTS.

1 WHEREAS, healthy and productive employees are the 2 cornerstone of successful businesses and a prosperous economy; 3 and 4 5 WHEREAS, unfortunately, many employees are subjected to unhealthy, abusive work environments where workplace bullying, 6 abuse, and harassment are prevalent occurrences, independent of 7 8 membership in a protected group; and 9 WHEREAS, as a result, these employees may experience 10 physical and psychological harm, which negatively impacts job 11 12 performance and job safety, often manifesting in injuries and 13 illnesses; and 14 WHEREAS, the National Institute for Occupational Safety and 15 Health recognizes general harassment, including workplace 16 bullying, as a form of workplace violence; and 17 18 19 WHEREAS, workplace bullying has been defined by the 20 National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health as the repeated intimidation, slandering, social isolation, or 21 humiliation by one or more persons against another; and 22 23 WHEREAS, the United States Congress has found that employee 24 injuries and illness that arise out of work situations impose a 25 substantial burden on businesses and that these injuries and 26 27 illnesses can be reduced through the establishment and enforcement of minimum health and safety standards; and 28 29 WHEREAS, accordingly, the Hawaii occupational safety and 30 health law ensures safe and healthful working conditions for all 31 employees throughout the State; and 32



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2 WHEREAS, in addition to the current protections under the 3 law, employees need protection from the repeated health-4 impairing mistreatment of one person by another to promote safe 5 and healthy work environments; now, therefore,

7 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-fifth 8 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2010, the 9 House of Representatives concurring, that the Department of 10 Labor and Industrial Relations is urged to adopt rules to 11 prohibit abusive work environments; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations is urged to develop and disseminate, at no cost to employers, information on abusive work environments and the legal consequences that employees or employers encounter if they contribute to the creation or perpetuation of abusive work environments; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this
Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Director of Labor
and Industrial Relations.
