## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO CONVENE A WORKING GROUP TO EXAMINE OVERLAP AND CONFLICTS AMONG STATUTES RELATING TO PATIENT CARE DIRECTIVES RECOGNIZED IN HAWAII, INCLUDING PHYSICIAN ORDERS FOR LIFE SUSTAINING TREATMENT, "DO NOT RESUSCITATE" ORDERS, AND ADVANCE HEALTH CARE DIRECTIVES.

WHEREAS, the Legislature enacted Act 186, Session Laws of
 Hawaii 2009, relating to physician orders for life sustaining
 treatment; and

5 WHEREAS, physician orders for life sustaining treatment 6 have been found by the State and other states to allow for 7 individuals to more clearly state their wishes for end-of-life 8 treatment in all pre-hospital and health care settings; and

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WHEREAS, Hawaii also recognizes:

(1) Do not resuscitate orders that direct health care providers to provide comfort care to a patient and refrain from resuscitating if the patient's heart or breathing stops; and

(2) Advance health care directives that provide assurance that decisions regarding future medical care will reflect a person's specific wishes if the person is incapacitated and that provide mechanisms to establish legally authorized decision-makers when the patient is incapacitated; and

24 WHEREAS, because Hawaii has multiple statutes involving a 25 range of procedures and directives dealing with a person's 26 health care choices, including end-of-life decisions, that may 27 lead to confusion, including physician orders for life 28 sustaining treatment, "do not resuscitate" orders, and advance 29 health care directives; now, therefore,
