## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

## REQUESTING THE AUDITOR TO CONDUCT A SUNRISE REVIEW OF THE REGISTRATION OF RESIDENT MANAGERS.

14 15 16	WHEREAS, resident managers are not specifically subject to regulation or oversight by any government body; and
17 18 19 20 21	WHEREAS, section 26H-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, requires that "[n]ew regulatory measures being considered for enactment that, if enacted, would subject unregulated professions and vocations to licensing or other regulatory controls shall be referred to the auditor for analysis"; and
22 23 24 25 26 27	WHEREAS, S.B. No. , introduced during the 2010 Regular Session, proposes the registration with the Real Estate Commission of resident managers who are employed by an association of a condominium, cooperative housing corporation, or planned unit development; now, therefore,
28 29 30 31 32 33	BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-fifth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2010, the House of Representatives concurring, that the Auditor is requested to perform a sunrise review of resident managers and assess whether the enactment of regulatory measures contained in
