SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THAT A TASK FORCE BE ESTABLISHED TO IDENTIFY THE LIBRARY SERVICES NEEDED IN UNDERSERVED COMMUNITIES AND SEEK COMMUNITY SOURCES OF FUNDING TO OFFSET THE LOSS OF FUNDING TO LIBRARIES.

2 democracy; and 3 WHEREAS, since Benjamin Franklin formed the first public 4 library, public libraries, which are open to all people 5 regardless of age, race, gender, social condition, and religion, 6 7 have been a major component of informing the public in all aspects of the informational spectrum; and 8 9 10 WHEREAS, the Hawaii State Public Library System has been 11 mandated to supply all the people of Hawaii with access to information and educational and recreational materials, while 12

WHEREAS, an informed citizenry is the foundation of

15 WHEREAS, the Hawaii State Public Library System has been 16 heavily impacted by both an increase in population in 17 underserved areas and the heavy expenses of updating and 18 supporting current informational technologies; and 19

preserving the right to privacy; and

20 WHEREAS, budgetary constraints have forced workforce 21 reductions of approximately seventy-eight positions out of 22 approximately five hundred eighty-four positions, and libraries 23 in Hawaii are now facing additional budget cuts; and

25 WHEREAS, adequate resources to correct this situation to 26 supply the people of Hawaii with the library and information 27 services necessary to maintain the basic standard of service are 28 not available; and

30 WHEREAS, this creates an inequity in service to the people31 of the State; now, therefore,

1 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-fifth 2 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2010, the 3 4 House of Representatives concurring, that the State Librarian is requested to establish a task force composed of representatives 5 of public and private organizations, philanthropic and 6 commercial organizations, governmental and nongovernmental 7 organizations, and cultural and geographic communities from all 8 islands; and 9 10 11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force is requested to identify the library services needed in underserved communities, 12 including resources that can be developed, and facilities, 13 14 collections, staffing, hours of operation, and services that will be needed; and 15 16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force is requested to 17 seek community sources of funding to offset the loss of funding 18 19 from the Department of Education to community and school 20 libraries; and 21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force is requested to 22 submit a report of its findings and recommendations to the 23 24 Legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of 25 the Regular Session of 2011; and 26 27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force shall become a permanent resource to assist the State Librarian in developing 28 and updating the Hawaii State Public Library System long-range 29 30 master plan; and 31 32 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 33 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the Board of Education and the State Librarian. 34
