SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING RECONSIDERATION AND REISSUANCE OF COMMERCIAL USE PERMITS FOR THE MOLOKINI SHOAL MARINE LIFE CONSERVATION DISTRICT AFTER CONSULTATION WITH AND THE PROVISION OF ADVANCE NOTICE TO COMMERCIAL TOUR OPERATORS.

1 WHEREAS, the ocean tourism industry is a vibrant and important industry to the State of Hawaii; and 2 3 WHEREAS, the National Ocean Economics Program reported that 4 Hawaii's direct ocean economy generated \$5,400,000,000 in 2004 5 which represents about 10.7 per cent of the State's gross 6 domestic product; and 7 8 9 WHEREAS, this industry employs almost one hundred thousand people with total wages exceeding \$2,500,000,000, making Hawaii 10 the lead state for employment in the ocean economy sector; and 11 12 WHEREAS, the health of the ocean tourism industry is 13 dependent upon the health of Hawaii's unique yet fragile ocean 14 environment; and 15 16 WHEREAS, the ocean and its resources must be managed to 17 accommodate not only commercial operators, but all the people of 18 Hawaii, including those with recreational and cultural interests 19 20 in our resources; and 21 WHEREAS, a limited number of commercial tour operators have 22 the privilege of conducting tours to the Molokini Shoal Marine 23 Life Conservation District using permits issued by the Division 24 of Aquatic Resources, Department of Land and Natural Resources, 25 which are typically issued for a set amount of time and subject 26 to certain terms and conditions; and 27 28 WHEREAS, those terms and conditions are important for the 29 maintenance of a pristine ocean environment at Molokini, and 30 must be adjusted from time to time in order to respond to 31 legitimate concerns regarding the future health of our ocean 32 resources; and 33 34



WHEREAS, these terms and conditions may also have a 1 significant economic impact on the operation of the tours, the 2 conduct of the passengers, employment and sales contracts, 3 working conditions, advertising materials, and the fulfillment 4 of expectations by those who pay to participate in tours; and 5 6 WHEREAS, thorough discussions with affected operators prior 7 8 to the establishment of new permit terms and conditions may alleviate unnecessary impacts on their operations, while still 9 addressing the resource protection concerns that fall under the 10 primary responsibilities of the Department of Land and Natural 11 Resources; and 12 13 WHEREAS, advance notice of new permit terms and conditions 14 may also provide operators adequate time to adjust their 15 16 operations to further alleviate any impacts; and 17 18 WHEREAS, recently commercial use permits with additional conditions were issued to commercial tour operators with no 19 advance notice, little consultation, and resulted in 20 21 jeopardizing existing tour contracts; now, therefore, 22 23 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-fifth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2010, 24 that the Department of Land and Natural Resources is requested 25 to reconsider and reissue the commercial use permits for the 26 27 Molokini Shoal Marine Life Conservation District after consultation with and the provision of advance notice to 28 commercial tour operators; and 29 30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Land and 31 32 Natural Resources is requested to ensure that Molokini Shoal Marine Life Conservation District commercial use permittees are 33 provided at least ninety days written notice of any changes in 34 35 conditions for commercial use permits; and 36 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Land and 37 38 Natural Resources is requested to consult with commercial use permittees on any changes in permit conditions and seek input 39 from the permittees on the advisability, practicality, and ease 40 of implementation of the proposed permit conditions; and 41 42



1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this Resolution be transmitted to Chairperson of the Board of Land 2 3 and Natural Resources. 4
