
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII SCHOOL OF TRAVEL INDUSTRY
MANAGEMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that under article X,
2 section 6 of the state constitution it is a matter of statewide
3 concern that the school of travel industry management at the
4 University of Hawaii at Manoa remain autonomous from the
5 Schidler college of business administration. The autonomy of
6 the school of travel industry management enables it to be the
7 most efficient of the schools and colleges that comprise the
8 University of Hawaii at Manoa. Such autonomy also enables the
9 school to remain competitive with its peer institutions in both
10 the nation and around the world.

11 The purpose of this Act is to establish a school of travel
12 industry management at the University of Hawaii at Manoa that is
13 separate and independent of any school or college of business
14 administration also established at the university.

15 SECTION 2. Chapter 304A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
16 amended by adding a new subpart to part IV to be appropriately
17 designated and to read as follows:
