
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DANGEROUS WEAPONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 134, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to part III to be appropriately
3 designated and to read as follows:
4 "§134- Explosive devices. (a) It shall be unlawful for
5 any person to construct, set off, ignite, discharge, or
6 otherwise cause to explode any homemade explosive device.
7 (b) Whoever knowingly or intentionally constructs, sets
8 off, ignites, discharges, or otherwise causes to explode any
9 homemade explosive device shall be guilty of a class C felony.
10 (c) For the purposes of this section "homemade explosive
11 device" means a non-commercially manufactured device composed of
12 a single ingredient, or mixture of ingredients, capable of
13 instantaneously releasing large amounts of energy that is
14 capable of inflicting substantial damage to persons or
15 property."




