A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO WASTE STREAM REDUCTION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that telephone
- 2 directories, such as the yellow pages and white pages, are
- 3 automatically distributed to consumers. Many of these
- 4 directories go unclaimed, causing litter and an unnecessary use
- 5 of resources. In an effort to reduce paper waste, directories
- 6 should be distributed only to those consumers who have
- 7 specifically requested them.
- 8 By comparison, the *MidWeek* tabloid is not automatically
- 9 distributed to consumers. It is mailed only to consumers who
- 10 have signed a postcard authorization for the mailing, which is
- 11 valid for three years. The postcard reads, "Postal regulations
- 12 require a signed request card from MidWeek readers to qualify
- 13 for Periodicals mailing privileges." The legislature finds that
- 14 adopting a similar approach with the distribution of telephone
- 15 directories will significantly reduce paper waste and
- 16 unnecessary use of resources.

- 1 The purpose of this Act is to require telephone directories to be distributed only to persons who have signed a written .2 authorization to receive the directory. 3 SECTION 2. Chapter 342H, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 4 5 amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately 6 designated and to read as follows: Distribution of telephone directories. (a) 7 "\$342H-Beginning January 1, 2012, a telephone directory distributor 8 9 shall not distribute telephone directories to any person, household, entity, or business without having first received a 10 request card signed by the person, a person residing at the 11 household, or a person representing the entity or business, 12 13 authorizing the telephone directory distribution; provided that any telephone directory distributor that has implemented an opt-14 out or opt-in program for the distribution of telephone 15 directories shall not be subject to this section. A self-16 addressed prepaid request card shall be mailed by the directory 17 distributor to each person, household, entity, or business from 18 which distribution authorization is sought. A signed request 19 20 card authorizing distribution shall be valid for three years and 21 may be renewed for an additional three-year period, without
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limit on the number of renewals.

1. (b) A request card under subsection (a) shall include 2 check-mark boxes to indicate the number of telephone directories 3 requested, if any, including locality directories and yellow 4 pages. 5 (c) Violators of this section shall be subject to a civil 6 fine of \$50 for each telephone directory distributed in 7 violation, to be imposed by the director. Any person, household, entity, or business may report a violation to the 8 9 department. 10 (d) As used in this section: 11 "Distribute" means the delivery or giving to another, or 12 leaving with another of a telephone directory. 13 "Telephone directory" means a book in which are listed 14 alphabetically the names of persons, businesses, and other 15 entities having telephones in a specified area, along with their addresses and telephone numbers. "Telephone directory" includes 16 17 locality directories and the yellow pages. 18 "Yellow pages" means a book or a section of a telephone 19 directory listing businesses, services, or products 20 alphabetically according to field."

SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.

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1 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
