He is a Hawaii licensed civil engineer and is Vice President of HDR/Hawaii Pacific Engineers. He has over thirty-three years of experience in planning, coordination, design, and construction services for various site development, repair, renovation, and new construction projects for the federal government, state government, and private industry.
