Your Committee received testimony in support of the nomination of Frances Paulette Hackbarth from the Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs. A personal statement and resume were received from the nominee.

Upon review of the testimony, your Committee finds that the nominee's professional experience, commitment to public service, and proven leadership on the Board of Psychology qualify her for reappointment as a public member to the Board of Psychology. Your Committee notes that Frances Paulette Hackbarth is a retired computer specialist with thirty-four years experience and has been an active volunteer in numerous community organizations since her retirement in 2001. This extensive volunteer service has enabled her to understand quickly the purpose of the Board and her role as a public member. Your Committee further finds that this nominee

has been reappointed to the Board of Psychology based on her knowledge, experience, and commitment to public service.
