Mr. Dunn is active in numerous professional and community organizations, including the Domestic Violence Task Force on Oahu, Hawaii Coalition Against Sexual Assault, and has served as an advisory board member for the Missing Child Center, Mothers Against Drunk Driving, and the Sex Abuse Treatment Center, among others.

Pursuant to Act 93, Session Laws of Hawaii 2009, Hawaii joined the new Interstate Compact for Juveniles, and established a state-level council under the Judiciary, known as the Hawaii State Council for Interstate Juvenile Supervision. Mr. Dunn's appointment is for the victim advocate for the Council.
