Your Committee received testimony in support of the
nomination of Faye M. Murayama from the Department of Taxation.

Upon review of the testimony, your Committee finds that the
nominee's accounting experience and commitment to community
service qualify her to serve on the Board of Taxation Review for
the 2nd Taxation District. Your Committee notes that Faye M.
Murayama is a certified public accountant and sole proprietor of
Faye Murayama, CPA, Inc., an accounting firm. Prior to starting


