Your Committee on Transportation, to which was referred H.B. No. 1162 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO PENALTIES FOR COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE VIOLATIONS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to improve highway safety and comply with federal regulations regarding commercial driver's licenses by:

- Increasing the maximum fine to \$25,000 for an employer convicted of allowing a driver, the commercial motor vehicle the driver is driving, or the motor carrier operation, that is subject to an out-of-service order to operate;
- (2) Prohibiting any individual from driving a commercial motor vehicle in violation of an out-of-service order; and
- (3) Establishing or increasing penalties for drivers convicted of operating a commercial motor vehicle:
  - (A) In violation of an out-of-service order;
  - (B) With alcohol in the body; and
  - (C) With a blood alcohol content of .04.

The Department of Transportation testified in support of this bill.


