"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO EDUCATION PROJECTS,"

beg leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to stimulate the state's economy by:

- Authorizing the issuance of and appropriating \$100,000,000 in general obligation bonds for improvements to or repair and maintenance of public schools; and
- Authorizing the issuance of and appropriating \$50,000,000 in general obligation bonds for improvements to or repair and maintenance of University of Hawaii (UH) instructional facilities.

This bill also allows these appropriations to be used to match federal funds that are appropriated for State capital improvement projects under any federal fiscal stimulus legislation.

The Department of Education and UH testified in support of this bill. The UH at Manoa supported the intent of this measure.
