Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred H.B. No. 1686, H.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO CHARTER SCHOOLS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to establish a funding mechanism to ensure that charter schools receive fair and equitable funding.

The Department of Education, Office of Hawaiian Affairs, Kamehameha Schools, West Hawaii Explorations Academy Public Charter School, and a concerned individual supported this bill. The Charter School Administrative Office (CSAO) and a concerned individual offered comments.

Your Committee has amended this bill by replacing its contents with provisions that:

- Eliminate the per-pupil method of funding for charter (1)schools, thus requiring charter schools to follow the same budgetary request process as other state agencies;
- Require the CSAO to submit a report of all means of (2) financing with its budgetary request to the Director of Finance; and
- Change the effective date to July 1, 2020, to encourage further discussion.
