Your Committee on Economic Revitalization, Business, & Military Affairs, to which was referred H.B. No. 464 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO STATE VETERANS' HOME,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to continue to support the wellbeing of Hawaii's veterans by:

- Establishing a Veterans' Gift Account (Account) within the Hawaii Health Systems Corporation (HHSC) to be administered by the Chief Executive Officer of HHSC;
- (2) Authorizing gifts of money to be deposited into the Account;
- (3) Allowing gifts of personal property to be sold, exchanged, or used in-kind if the gift is not appropriate for conversion to money; and
- (4) Authorizing the Chief Executive Officer of HHSC to use the gifts of money or personal property deposited into the Veterans' Gift Account only in a manner authorized by the donor.

The Office of Veterans Services testified in support of the intent of this bill. HHSC provided comments.

Your Committee has amended this bill by:

- Changing its effective date to July 1, 2112, to encourage further discussion; and
- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for clarity, consistency, and style.
