The IUCN is the world's oldest and largest global environmental network, with more than one thousand government and non-government organization members. The IUCN helps the world find pragmatic solutions to our most pressing environment and development challenges and supports scientific research, manages field projects all over the world, and brings together governments, non-government organizations, United Nations agencies, companies, and local communities to develop and implement policy, laws, and best practices. The World Conservation Congress is the general assembly of the IUCN members and meets every four years. Your Committees find that Hawaii is ideally poised to host the 2016 World Conservation Congress, as

its geographic location serves as a bridge from the West to Oceania and Asia. A typical World Conservation Congress lasts two weeks and attracts approximately eight thousand delegates from around the world, and Honolulu has the capability and facilities required to host this international event.
