- (2) Changing the title to read, "REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF HAWAIIAN HOME LANDS TO EXPLORE OPPORTUNITIES TO REVISE ITS PRESENT POLICIES ON MATTERS OF SUCCESSORSHIP"; and
