Your Committee on Ways and Means, to which was referred S.B.
No. 1096, S.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO TECHNOLOGY WORKFORCE AND
DEVELOPMENT,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to appropriate funds for the
science-, technology-, engineering-, and math-related (STEM)
programs in Hawaii's public schools and charter schools.

More specifically, the purpose of this measure is to provide
additional funds to ensure that all interested schools will be
able to provide STEM programs in 2009-2012. In addition, the
measure provides funding for the K-12 after-school creative media
education initiatives.

Your Committee received one written comment on this measure.
The written comment may be reviewed on the Legislature's website.

Your Committee finds that STEM and creative media programs
are important to prepare Hawaii's students for further education
and employment and ensure their success in the global economy.

Upon further consideration, your Committee has amended this
measure by:

- (1) Changing the effective date to July 1, 2070, to
facilitate further discussion; and



- (2) Making technical nonsubstantive changes for purposes of clarity and style.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Ways and Means that is attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of S.B. No. 1096, S.D. 1, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Third Reading in the form attached hereto as S.B. No. 1096, S.D. 2.
