Your Committees on Energy and Environment and Transportation, International and Intergovernmental Affairs, to which was referred S.B. No. 2231 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO ELECTRIC VEHICLES,"

beg leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to exempt from the general excise tax the proceeds arising from the sale or lease of electric vehicles and electric vehicle charging systems purchased or placed in service from July 1, 2010 to before January 1, 2020.

Testimony in support of the measure was submitted by one state agency and four organizations. One organization submitted comments. Written testimony presented to the Committees may be reviewed on the Legislature's website.

This measure is part of the Hawaii Clean Energy Initiative's 2010 policy recommendations to help Hawaii meet the Initiative's qoal of seventy per cent clean, renewable energy by 2030.

Your Committees find that Hawaii offers ideal conditions for electric vehicles: most residents drive short daily distances, the state has well-defined boundaries within which to build the required infrastructure, and the mild climate lends to greater battery performance and longevity. Electric vehicles are cleaner, quieter, and more efficient than gasoline powered vehicles, and, because they depend upon the electrical power grid, can be powered using renewable energy sources such as wind, geothermal, wave, and

solar. The expanded use of electric vehicles will greatly reduce Hawaii's dependence on fossil fuels.

As affirmed by the records of votes of the members of your Committees on Energy and Environment and Transportation, International and Intergovernmental Affairs that are attached to this report, your Committees are in accord with the intent and purpose of S.B. No. 2231 and recommend that it pass Second Reading and be referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.
